## About My Work

1. You are required to use CLOVR service for your work. An account will be given to each group for the service.
2. Using unauthorized tools, materials or whatsoever will result in disqualification and revocation of any prizes. You will also earn a permanent ban in any of our future hackathons. We will not be responsible for any legal actions taken. You have been warned.
3. Likewise, we will respect the intellectual property of your creation. We encourage open innovation and collaboration, but should you wish your project to remain private in the hackathon, we will not publish it anywhere.
4. Be fair to other participants. We get it, sometimes preparations are needed prior to the event, but you should not start development prior to the event. You are here to create. Winning is a secondary bonus.
5. Creativity doesn't mean extremism. Creations violating our code of conducts are not welcomed.
6. Violation of any of the above rules might result in an immediate disqualification, or penalty on the judging.

# CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Brawls and any form of conflict is prohibited among the participants, regardless of whether or not they are in a group or competing against one another. All interactions between participants and committee alike are to remain professional throughout the event.
2. Discrimination will not be taken lightly if found in a topic of conversation, or if found as a theme in the project of the group. Any discrimination — including but not limited to racial discrimination, misogynistic/misanthropic comments, etc — found will result in an immediate disqualification.
3. Items that may potentially bring harm to any individual is strictly prohibited. Examples of such are: alcohol, any sharp or blunt object that can cause injuries, firearms, etc.
4. Any form of harassment, both verbal and physical, and of any insensitive topic is a serious offense. Any display of harassment will result in the participant being disqualified from the competition.
5. The decision of the judges will be final under any circumstances.
6. Smoking is prohibited at all times on site.
7. The facilities found on the ground is to be tended to with care. Kindly do not break the any of the facilities available for the good of the participants.
8. Wear appropriate attires at all times throughout the time spent on the site. No attires deemed inappropriate and unacceptable by government standards.
